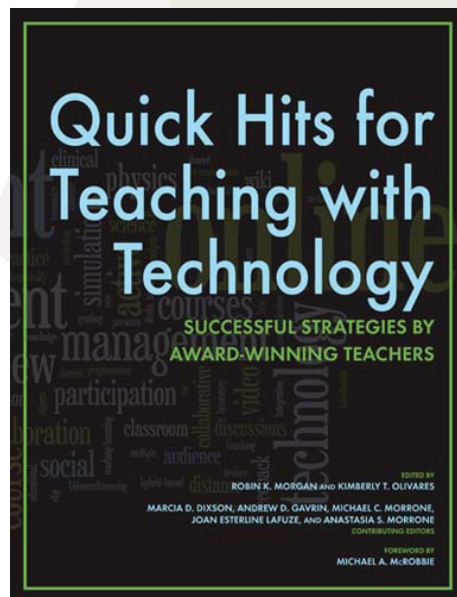
The Retreat Planning Committee are pleased to announce our Keynote Speaker for our Retreat, Dr. Dan Bernstein

from the University of Kansas. Dan is a professor of psychology and the director of their Center for Teaching Excellence. Beginning with a self-paced introductory course that brought a large percentage of learners to high levels of achievement, Dan has designed courses at all levels of higher education that make learner understanding the primary goal. His primary research focused on human motivation and learning, including work with adults and children in non-laboratory settings. Most recently he has been exploring and evaluating various uses of technology to promote student understanding. Conventional experimental studies have looked at the impact of multimedia presentations on student cognitive performance, and his ongoing courses are a laboratory for evaluating the impact of out of class web-based activities on deep understanding of conceptual material. Dan has received numerous campus awards for teaching, he was a Charter Member of the University of Nebraska Academy of Distinguished Teachers, and he received the 2001 University of Nebraska Outstanding Teaching and Instructional Creativity Award. He is a Fellow of the Carnegie Academy for the Scholarship of Teaching and Learning.
