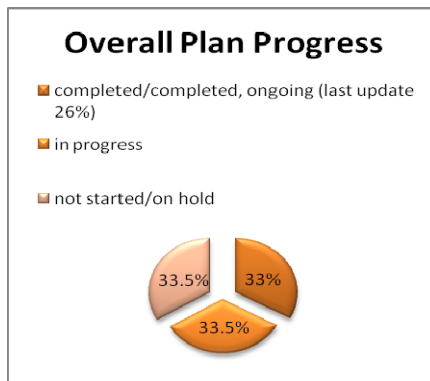
**2008-2009 accomplishments**

- Successfully implemented contract to provide up to 260 residential students in off campus facility (Park Place).
- The residential student leader staff was increase by seven to support increased residents at Park Place.
- Conducted a feasibility study for Campus Housing Phase II through Anderson Strickler. The study will be presented to the IU Board of Trustees in the near future.
- The Housing and Residence Life Administrative Offices were relocated and old office were converted to residential student spaces.
- Created new Area Coordinator position and restructured other positions (GA for diversity education and GA for housing administration) to better serve the needs of a growing department and student staff.
- Vacant space in Ball Hall basement was remodeled and is being utilized as a classroom for a first year seminar.
- Audio/video equipment was upgraded and/or added to two conference rooms in the campus apartments.
- Integrated StrengthsQuest into student staff training and supervision. The Assistant Director attended national StrengthsQuest Conference.
- Continued with the installation and implementation of CBORD housing management database. We are on schedule to accept online applications for fall 2010 applicants.
- The Corner (the student run convenience store at the Campus Apartments) received many new enhancements and expanded product offerings. Monthly visitors average 2,500.
- Summer student assistant staff was expanded from 6 to 11 positions.
- Over 60 % of the items on the Housing and Residence Life strategic plan are either completed or in progress. HRL is in the second year of a five year strategic plan (see second page for detail).
- A total of 73 student staff members are employed by Housing and Residence Life (see second page for detail).
- Over 200 educational and social programs were sponsored by resident assistants and LYFE leaders during fall and spring semesters.
- A total of 51 diversity programs during fall and spring semesters.
- A total of 12 civic engagement programs were sponsored during the fall and spring semesters

- Based on Residential Satisfaction Survey (RSS) results, approximately 60% of campus residents indicate that they would recommend living on-campus to a friend or family member (Ball, Apts and Park Place results combined)
- Based on RSS results, approximately 69% of campus residents indicate that they would recommend living on-campus to a friend or family member (Ball and Apts only)
- Based on RSS results, 41% of campus residents Strongly Agree that they feel safe and secure in their residence, with another 47% Agreeing.
