STATISTICAL REPORT OF THE AMERICAN GYMNASTIC UNION.

To the Members of the American Gymnastic Union,
Greetings!

According to the statistical reports of January 1, 1922, the American Gymnastic Union comprises 22 districts with 172 societies, against 177 societies one year ago. The membership of the Union and of the various classes was as follows:

The Gymnastic Association consists of 48,023 (48,545) members over 14 years of age, and 14,267 (14,209) under 14 years of age. (Figures in parenthesis are those of the previous year.) The various classes of the societies are attended by 31,027 (29,882) persons. 125 (121) societies employ instructors; 158 (158) societies are incorporated; 135 (142) own their buildings, and 144 (145) are subscribers to the official publication. 391 (411) Juniors were admitted to membership during 1921, and 445 (491) members died. PHYSICAL EDUCATION IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

The 32nd National Tournament.

The 32nd National Gymnastic and Athletic Tournament was held in Chicago, June 29th to July 3rd. The program included society and individual competition; for the first time women took part in competition at national festivals. There were so many different activities that the technical committee must be congratulated upon the well planned program which permitted the conclusion of the competition and drills at the stated time. Credit is also due to the technical committee of Chicago which had put the grounds at Riverview Park in excellent condition. Nearly 1000 men and 800 women took part; there were also about 400 participants in the mass exercise of the senior men. A complete report of the results follows:

Normal College.

The Normal College of the American Gymnastic Union, now conducting its fourteenth course since its removal to Indianapolis, has during the past year made important improvements by acquiring property at Elkhart Lake, Wis., where the summer sessions will henceforth be conducted in camp, and where a four weeks' course in camping, etc., will also be given to the regular class at the close of each year. A hotel formerly conducted by W. Fleck, will be operated by the College for Turners and their families and friends.

The Board of Trustees of the College consists of the following members: President, Franklin Vonnegut; Secretary, George Vonnegut; Treasurer, Carl H. Lieber; Theo. Stempfel; A. E. Kindervater, St. Louis; W. A. Stecher, Philadelphia; Henry Suder, Chicago; Dr. Carl Ziegler, Cincinnati; Emil Rath, President of the College and Dean of the Department of Theory and Practice of Physical Education; Dr. H. O. Pantzer, Dean of the Department of Anatomy, Physiology, and Hygiene; Peter Scherer, Dean of the Department of Letters and General Science. The faculty consisting of seventeen instructors, includes members of the teaching staff of the Indiana University School of Medicine, Butler College, and the Indianapolis high schools.

Courses offered:

A four-year course leading to the degree of Bachelor of Science in Gymnastics (B. S. G.) and to certification as Teacher of Physical Training for Colleges and Universities.

Graduate courses leading to the degree of Master of Science in Gymnastics (M. S. G.)

A two-year course leading to the title of Graduate in Gymnastics (G. G.) and to certification as Teacher of Physical Training for Elementary and Higher Public Schools.

An elementary one-year course, open to male non-matriculantes who have attained a high degree of proficiency in gymnastics (gymnasts of the second or third grade), and meet such additional requirements as may be prescribed, including a satisfactory knowledge of German. Students who com-

plete this course receive a certificate to the effect that they are qualified to teach gymnastics in schools maintained by societies of the American Gymnastic Union.

Summer courses, comprising special courses in the theory and practice of physical training, and in related subjects. These courses are open to persons who are qualified to pursue profitably the work chosen by them. Credit and certificates will be given for work satisfactorily completed.

Complete information about these courses is given in the catalog of the Normal College and in the special summer session program; both publications will be sent to any address upon request.

A special summer course for members of the American Gymnastic Union who have passed the class leaders' examinations, is also given and leads to certification as instructor for gymnastic societies. A separate circular contains further information.

Scholarships. Beginning with the year 1919-20 the Board of Trustees of the Normal College has offered seven scholarships to members of the American Gymnastic Union (one for each of the circuits), consisting of free tuition and books for the two-year course. Full information about these scholarships will be sent upon request.

The 27th convention also decided to offer similar scholarships to 23 members without the high school education required for those mentioned above (one for each of the districts) consisting of free tuition for the elementary one-year course. Complete information will be sent upon request.

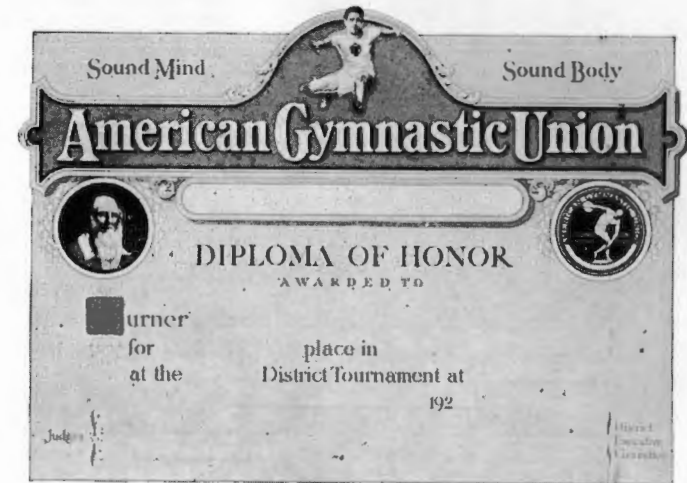

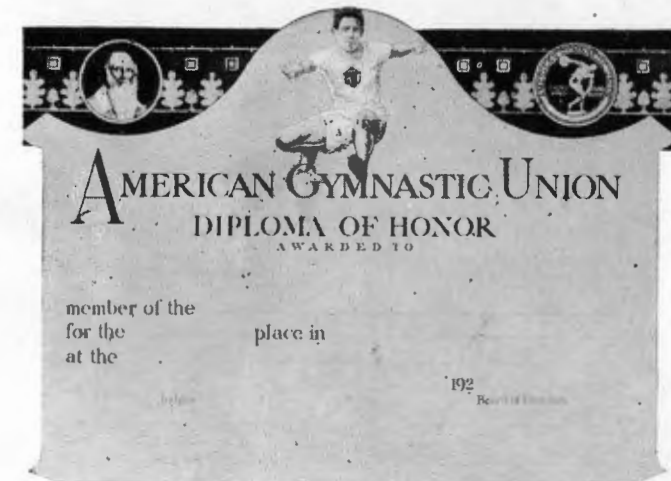
