## Eligibility for Blood Donation

For questions regarding eligibility, contact Magon Works [mtworks@indianablood.org](mailto:mtworks@indianablood.org)

Most people are eligible to donate. There are very few causes for deferral; very few medications that are not acceptable. Donors cannot be taking antibiotics for infection. Cancer patients must be one year cancer free. Heart patients must be 6 months symptom free. Diabetics can donate. It is recommended that donors have a light snack before donating – feel free to have some of our juice and cookies. Be sure to bring your picture ID!

The entire process of donating takes less than an hour. This is a very small sacrifice to possibly give someone more days to spend with their family. About a pint of blood is collected during the procedure. Males have about 9-12 units and females have about 7-10 units. These fluids replace in about 24 hours.

Indiana Blood Center is charged with collecting 550 units every day to be able to supply over 60 Indiana hospitals. Your donation can save up to 3 lives. Every unit counts!

Submit your fee of \$219, checks payable to South Grove Golf Course, by **Friday, May 8th, 4:00PM (DST)**  
Fees may be dropped off in the Physical Plant to me or Room PL 112, 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM (DST).

The IUPUI Golf League will play the BACK nine at South Grove Golf Course on MONDAYS. Play will last for fourteen (14) weeks, schedule begins Monday, May 18th, thru Monday, August 24th, skipping Monday, May 25th (Memorial Day). Any rainouts will push the end date back by one (1) week per makeup rain date. Rainouts will be called by the Course and notification will be as prompt as possible by email.

\$182 Green Fee (14 weeks x \$13 per round)

Fees are per person, non-refundable. The fee for the entire year will be paid at the start of the league.

Tee Times: PLEASE INDICATE YOUR TEE TIME PREFERENCE (IN WRITING) WHEN SUBMITTING YOUR MEMBERSHIP FEE. First Come – First Reserved. Tee times **MUST** be chosen at the beginning of the league, and are fixed for ALL 14 weeks. If you would like to change your tee time in the future, you will need to contact another member to arrange a different tee time. Tee times run from 4:30 to 5:30, alternating every 7 and 8 minutes. Play will be in foursomes.

See the schedule on the next page for tee times. Requested tee times may conflict. We will need to be flexible for this to work out. Those with no written tee time preference will be assigned next available tee time.

Prizes: No handicap system is available like last year. Course required \$25 prize fund will be returned to each golfer. However, members may choose to pool their money for competitive play in a format of their choosing.

Substitutions: Player substitutions may be made on your own if you are unable to play on a given date. Fees are still the responsibility of the member and are non-refundable. If you cannot play the entire season, contact me. One person has expressed interest in playing a partial season. I will provide contact info so you can possibly share a season.

- Find out if Buy 1, get 1 free card provided again this year
- Minimum # of foursomes for league to exist
