Teaching Innovations

“Growing the scholarship of teaching and learning through institutional culture change” is the title of an article appearing in the most recent issue of the *Journal of the Scholarship of Teaching and Learning (JoSoTL)*. The authors, Ginsberg & Bernstein, outline a five step model they utilized in bringing SoTL work front and center at Eastern Michigan University. A major obstacle in establishing SoTL on almost any campus is making “... the case that scholarly inquiries into student learning represents true scholarship that should be counted as such by the university.” Traditional categories of service, teaching, and scholarship hinder this view.

Although many IU faculty are involved in SoTL work, few faculty would consider such work to have the same cachet as traditional scholarship, what Boyer would call the scholarship of discovery. How can we implement a change in our IU culture to bring the value of this research to the forefront with promotion and tenure committees, administrators, and our colleagues? What role can FACET play in facilitating this paradigm shift? Join us on Facebook for continued discussions on this topic and others raised in the monthly newsletter.
