Gentlemen:

You are aware of the need for additional hot water at the park. It has been brought to my attention that the Federation Board turned down our request at their meeting on Tuesday, April 5.

It is interesting to note that in that same meeting they voted to buy a tapper box for the Blue Room for \$400. The present refrigerator isn't satisfactory anymore.

My original proposal was to have the festival committee, not the whole organization, approve the purchase of a water heater and write it off as an expense of the festival. Of course, 50 percent of the expense would be paid by the German-American Klub because of the needs for the OKTOBERFEST.

Therefore, I ask that you gentlemen have a meeting of the officers only of both clubs and approve the purchase of a heater.

In the event that the purchase is not approved you can then immediately appoint a new Chairman for the Heimath-Preussen Festival. I refuse to serve in that capacity unless we have a new heater.

If it is approved it will be installed on a temporary basis, not permanently. It will be stored someplace other than the park when not in use.

Please consider this request as a recommendation.
