McNair Postbaccalaureate Achievement Program) and Sung Kyung Kim (Undergraduate Research Opportunities Program) delivered the student addresses during this year's IUPUI Commencement. Gaston (School of Public and Environmental Affairs) conducted research in the area of criminal justice. Her work looks at *Who Are the Unclaimed Dead?* a descriptive analysis of the demographics and circumstances of the unclaimed dead in Marion County. After graduation, Shytierra plans to pursue a doctorate in criminology and criminal justice. Kim (School of Science) earned a bachelor's degree and will continue her studies with the aspirations of becoming a cardiothoracic surgeon and working as a missionary doctor among children with congenital heart problems. 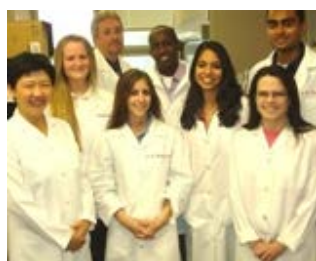
