## MEMORANDUM

We have met with the faculty and staff of Ivy Tech State College and have worked out the attached Articulation Agreement for the associate degree in accounting effective Fall, 1998.

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## KELLEY SCHOOL OF BUSINESS PROGRAM ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

This agreement of articulation relates to students who have completed an AS in Accounting Technology or an AAS in Accounting Technology at Ivy Tech State College, Indianapolis Campus.

The Kelley School of Business, Indianapolis Campus agrees to accept these Ivy Tech graduates provided:

1. The student has a 2.5 grade point average.
2. The student has completed the following classes (shown with IUPUI course numbers) at Ivy Tech State College, IUPUI, or transferred from an accredited university:
 

Finite Math	Math M118
Calculus	Math M119
Microeconomics	Econ E201
Macroeconomics	Econ E202
Statistics	Econ E270
3. Prior to admission, or after admission to the Kelley School of Business, students must complete 50 credit hours in courses other than business and economics to graduate with a Bachelors of Science in Business degree.
4. Undistributed Business classes will count towards junior class standing but will not meet the requirements of similarly titled upper level classes.

Students meeting these criteria will be admitted to the Kelley School of Business, Indianapolis Campus with junior standing.

As a part of this articulation agreement, the Kelley School of Business agrees to have faculty assist Ivy Tech faculty develop course syllabi for Accounting ACC 101 & 102; Introduction to Business Bus 101; and Business Law Bus 102. Further, the Kelley School of Business will provide peer review in these classes to insure continued articulation.

This articulation is limited to Ivy Tech State College, Indianapolis Campus and the Kelley School of Business, Indianapolis Campus and has no effect on any other Indiana University Campus.

This agreement is effective as of ~~Spring~~<sup>Fall</sup> semester 1998, except for courses covered by other articulation agreements.
