ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
between
INDIANA UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF NURSING –SYSTEM-WIDE
and
IVY TECH COMMUNITY COLLEGE-SYSTEM-WIDE
FOR THE TRANSFER OF THE
ASSOCIATE OF SCIENCE IN NURSING (A.S.N.) DEGREE
into the
BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN NURSING (B.S.N.) DEGREE

The purpose of the Articulation Agreement is to provide a framework for students at Ivy Tech Community College-system-wide to facilitate the continuation of their education toward the baccalaureate degree in nursing at the Indiana University School of Nursing (IUSON) system-wide.


To ensure the smooth transition from the associate degree to the bachelor degree, the faculty of both system-wide institutions have agreed that any graduate of the Associate of Science in Nursing (A.S.N.) at Ivy Tech Community College with a minimum cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of 2.5, and who is licensed as a registered nurse (R.N.) in Indiana will be admitted to Indiana University's Bachelor of Science in Nursing (B.S.N.) program at any one of the IUSON campuses under the provisions of this articulation agreement. The registered nurse student will obtain junior status upon successful completion of six credit hours of bridging course work. The registered nurse student will receive special credit for a minimum of 34 IU nursing credits toward the B.S.N. degree.


Transferring of general education credit will be consistent with the articulation agreements and policies and practices in place on each IUSON campus at the time of application to the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (B.S.N.) program.


All qualified Ivy Tech Community College A.S.N. graduates will be accommodated into their chosen IUSON B.S.N. program if they apply within one year of graduation. Those Ivy Tech Community College A.S.N. graduates applying more than one year out from graduation will be admitted on the basis of available space and resources.

To ensure the currency of this agreement, the Nursing leadership of IUSON and Ivy Tech Community College will meet biennially to review terms and curriculum changes, and then re-affirm this agreement in light of their evaluation





SCHOOL OF NURSING

This memo is intended to serve as the BSN program articulation agreement between the Indiana University School of Nursing (IUSON) at Indiana University-Purdue University at Indianapolis (IUPUI) and the Ivy Tech State College, Indianapolis campus.

Any student who has completed the Associate of Science in Nursing (ASN) at Ivy Tech, is licensed as a registered nurse (RN) in Indiana, and has achieved at least a 2.5 grade point average (GPA) will be admitted to Indiana University's Bachelor's of Science in Nursing (BSN) program at IUPUI under the provisions of this articulation agreement; and after successfully completing six credits of bridging courses will have junior class standing. The bridging courses have didactic and clinical components: TRANSITION TO PROFESSIONAL NURSING I--didactic B204, 2 credits, and clinical B250, 1 credit--, and TRANSITION TO PROFESSIONAL NURSING II--didactic B404, 2 credits, and clinical B450, 1 credit.

To facilitate this articulation, undistributed credit will be given by IUPUI to Ivy Tech's BIO 111 and BIO 112--General Microbiology I and II--, until an articulation agreement is reached regarding equivalency for these two courses.

To ensure that all concerned understand this agreement and counsel students appropriately, the IUPUI/Ivy Tech Office of Coordinated Programs will sponsor counselor training for IUPUI and Ivy Tech personnel, under the joint leadership of IUSON's Associate Dean for Undergraduate Programs and Ivy Tech's Director of Nursing at Indianapolis. Ongoing information sharing between the aforementioned parties will be encouraged so Ivy Tech students on the Indianapolis campus can be apprised of all opportunities available at or through IUPUI for computer-mediated instruction, on-site admission or registration, other mobility options (e.g., RN-MSN), etc.

There will be no limitation on the number of qualified Ivy Tech graduates of the Indianapolis campus who can be accommodated by IUPUI's RN-BSN program within one year of their graduation. Those students applying after one year from graduation will be admitted on the basis of available resources and space.

To insure the currency of this agreement, the nursing leadership of IUPUI and Ivy Tech will meet annually to review terms and curriculum changes, then re-affirm this agreement in light of their evaluation.
