The Accelerated Master's Program (A.M.P.) is a competitive program for outstanding SPEA students. Students may apply to the Master of Public Affairs (M.P.A.), the Master of Health Administration (M.H.A.) or the Master of Science in Environmental Science (M.S.E.S.) programs early in their junior year. On the Fort Wayne campus, students may also apply to the Master of Public Management (M.P.M.) program.

Participation in this program allows the student to fulfill some graduate program requirements during the senior year. Graduate courses count for both graduate and undergraduate degree requirements. Before starting the graduate program, students must have satisfied **all** general education requirements with a minimum of 96 credit hours completed toward their bachelor's degree (90 credit hours for students seeking the M.H.A. degree).
