FACET is pleased to announce the creation of two new programs:

Programming mini-grants and the Bender FACET Faculty Fellow program.

Up to \$5000 will be available through programming mini-grants to assist in funding campus speakers. Proposals will be considered on a first-come, first-served basis beginning August 1st of each year and will be judged on the basis of the significance of the anticipated outcomes for improving teaching and student learning. Proposals reflecting multi-campus or multi-institution speakers will be given higher priority.

The Bender FACET Faculty Fellow program, named in honor of FACET founder Eileen Bender, was developed to create leadership opportunities within FACET, particularly for newer members. The Bender FACET Fellow Program prepares members to gain a greater understanding of the system-wide impact of FACET. Up to two faculty members each semester will work on a specified project at the statewide level in cooperation with the FACET statewide office. Teaching Innovations

The latest edition of *Quick Hits: Teaching with Technology* has just been submitted to IU Press. As with prior volumes in the Quick Hits Series, this volume focuses on award winning teaching faculty sharing their successes.
