Dear Friends of the Community Foundation Serving Howard, Carroll and Clinton Counties:



Ways to Give

Flexible Giving

The Community Foundation is a flexible vehicle for charitable gifts of all sizes from public, corporate, foundation, or private sources. Both large and small gifts can take a variety of forms; depending on tax and estate planning priorities. Gifts can be made with:

- Cash
- Life Insurance
- Bequests
- Appreciated Securities
- Real Estate
- Private Foundation Transfer

IRA, 401(k), or Other Qualified Retirement Plan

Planned giving is as easy as designating a percentage of your IRA, 401(k) or other qualified retirement plan to the Foundation as a beneficiary.

Other Planned Gifts

The Foundation also offers donors several other types of gift arrangements that provide a variety of tax advantages and income benefits to donors. These include the following:

Charitable Gift Annuity

This is a contract between the donor and the Foundation. In exchange for the donor's irrevocable gift, the Foundation agrees to pay one or two annuities the donor names a fixed sum each year for life. The payments are guaranteed by the Foundation.

Charitable Remainder Trust

This allows donors to place assets such as cash, securities, or real estate in trust, which then invests the asset. The trust provides income to the donor or loved one for life or a term of years. The trust balance goes to the Foundation for a charity of the donor's choice.

Charitable Lead Trust

During the trust's term, the trustee invests the trust's assets and pays the income to the Foundation for the purpose the donor designates. When the trust term ends, assets are distributed to a loved one.

Retained Life Estate

This allows donors to give their home or farm to the Foundation, while retaining the right to live in it for the rest of their lives. At the end of the donor's life, the property is sold and the proceeds are used to establish a fund that carries out the donor's charitable wishes.

Types of Funds

Unrestricted Community Endowment Funds

Recognizing that the community's challenges and needs will change, donors have established community endowment funds to address these needs now and forever. Donors can entrust the Foundation with the selection of the most needed programs to receive grant funding based on a competitive process.

Donor-Advised Funds

Donors may be actively involved in the grantmaking by recommending which qualified charitable organizations should receive grants from their advised fund. These flexible funds enable donors to address a wide variety of issues as their charitable interests and priorities change over time.

Designated/Agency Funds

Donors may identify one or more charitable organizations to receive an income stream forever. If at some time in the future the named charity is no longer recognized as a 501(c)(3) organization, the Foundation board of directors has the variance power to select another organization with a similar purpose to benefit from the fund.

Field of Interest Funds

A field of interest fund allows donors to support a broadly defined area, such as the arts, youth, health and more. The Foundation awards funding through a competitive process to the most needed programs within the donor's area of interest of the fund.

Operating Endowment Funds

Donors support the work of the Community Foundation through their gifts to operating endowment funds, which provides support to the operating budget of the Foundation forever.

Scholarship Funds

Donors may customize a scholarship fund to provide educational opportunities for graduates of certain schools, for studies in specific fields or for programs at particular institutions of higher education.

Non-Permanent Funds

These funds are designated for short-term programs or special projects.

WALK A TRAIL THROUGH CANAL HISTORY

Go See and discover more 19th century transportation features on a walking tour of the only watered public accessible section of the Wabash & Erie Canal remaining in Indiana. This bird's-eye map of Wabash & Erie Canal Park spotlights major points of interest along a three-mile length of the Canal. Including a one-mile re-watered segment developed for interpretive and recreational activities.

We welcome you to tour the Canal Museum at the Wabash & Erie Canal Interpretive Center. There you will find display panels and interactive exhibits to further your understanding of life along the canal. The Center also supports an archive room, devoted to our rich canal heritage, which can be accessed by appointment.

- 1 Tumble:** Go See the "tumble" where water enters the Canal - today three million gallons of clean water per day comes from the local stone quarry to supply water for this historic canal. In the 1850s the local source was the Wabash River.
- 2 The Red Bridge:** Go See an 1874 Bowstring Pony Arch structure that once sat over Paint Creek east of Camden, Indiana, and was restored by volunteers in 1999.
- 3 Lime Kilns:** Go See archaeological remnants, a restored kiln, and what became one of the largest industries in the region producing exceptional quality plaster, mortar and whitewash.
- 4 Hubbard and Hartley Warehouse:** Go See the 1850s warehouse where the canal boat stays when not in use. In 1857 through 1874 canal barges delivered Delphi lime to distant parts from this point.
- 5 Paint Bridge and Mill:** Go See these reconstructed structures and experience how a road or pedestrian crossing over the Canal could swing out of the way for boat traffic. Diversed water from the Canal powered the mill.
- 6 Stone Arch Bridge:** Go See the 1901 Stone Arch as use today as vehicles pass over while the boat The Delphi passes under this arch. It replaced two earlier bridge spans.
- 7 Canal Village:** Go See the craft shops and experience the old ways of the early settlers who created items they needed in daily life.
- 8 Gray Bridge:** Go See the 1913 Pratt Through Truss disassembled and moved here from Putnam County, Indiana, now fully restored by volunteers to serve pedestrian trail traffic and connect to downtown Delphi.
- 9 Relay Station:** Go See the Gray Barn where horses or mules once pulled canal boats.
- 10 Guard Lock:** Go See the full-size gates of a replica lock built by volunteers, that guarded the lower navigation against floodwaters.
- 11 The Depot:** Go See a rail station model that was improved by volunteers. The Canal's business depended on rail technology improved offering faster moving transportation and all-season.

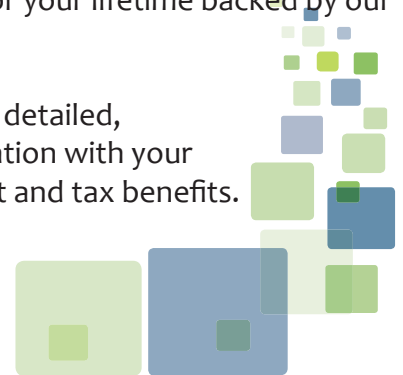
